PERSONALIZED FAMILY MATROYSHKA DOLLS

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Decide who your five dolls will be and make some quick sketches. Choose a defining characteristic or two for each person.
2. Sketch in the face using color first (being sure to leave a space for the eyes). Add hair. Then add black to create the features and further define the head. Don't focus on making it all
3. Add hands. Nothing fancy - just four finger-ish things.
4. Place representative objects into the hands. Use the same color first and then outline in black technique.
5. On the back of each doll, add the initial of the person represented. You can make it as fan-
- cy or as plain as you'd like. Add detailing with an extra fine point Pen Touch marker.
6. If you wish, you can finish off the dolls by varnishing them. I put a small amount of varnish onto a piece of palette paper and applied it to the dolls using a cosmetic wedge sponge.

- * Blank Nesting Dolls
- * Sakura Permapaque Markers
- * Scrap Paper
- * Pen or Pencil to Sketch
- * Pen Touch
- * White - Extra Fine Point
- * Optional: Varnish, Palette Paper, Cosmetic Sponge
