

Painted Images and Complement Layers

Materials List

- White gesso, Dina Wakley Media
- Watercolor paper by Ranger
- Dina Wakley Media acrylic paint (Sky, Turquoise, Night, Cheddar, Fuchsia)
- Paint brushes
- Black Fudeball pen
- Scissors
- Idea-ology Small Talk stickers
- Collage Glue Stick by Ranger
- Mask from Funky Masks by Dina Wakley Media
- Your journal
- Idea-ology Distress Sprayer
- Jet Black Archival Ink by Ranger
- Scribbly Birds in Flight stamps by Dina Wakley Media
- Idea-ology grid block

Tip:

1. Gesso a journal page and let it dry.
2. Apply Fuchsia and Cheddar paint to a piece of watercolor paper. Add water from the Distress Sprayer to the paint to mix it a bit. Let it dry.
3. Paint some Sky paint onto your background.
4. Put the mask down and paint around it with Lime paint.
5. Apply Night paint to the mask and press it onto your page to make a print of the mask. Let the background dry.
6. Stamp images into watercolor yardstick with Jet Black Archival ink.
7. Water down some Fuchsia and Cheddar paint. Apply Cheddar to the birds, leaving some areas white. Apply Fuchsia around the edges.
8. Water down Night paint and splatter it onto the images while the other paint is wet.
9. Cut a scallop from the painted watercolor paper and scribble around it with the black pen. Also write journaling on the scallop if desired.
10. Glue the scallop onto the page.
11. Cut out the birds and glue them onto the page.
12. Add a quote from the Small Talk sticker quote book.
