Making Washer Earrings By Jenn Mason

Use shrink plastic to create lighter-weight components for jewelry.

Materials needed:
ScanNCut – Brother International Corporation
Shrink plastic- Grafix
Jewelry tools
Jewelry findings and beads as desired.
Gloves
Heat gun
Marker (for forming plastic)
Sketching supplies

Instructions:

- 1. Use your sketching supplies to plan out your earring design.
- 2. Determine pieces to create out of shrink plastic and cut out of the plastic using an electric cutter or punches, making sure to cut out pieces about 2 times larger than the desired finished size.
- 3. Use a heat gun on a safe surface to shrink the cut plastic pieces one at a time following the manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. If plastic shaping is desired, immediately mold hot plastic on marker barrel with gloves on.
- 5. Use Jewelry tools to assemble your jewelry findings, beads, and shrink plastic pieces to match your sketch design.

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
