

Collaged Tags

Materials List

- Collage papers like unfinished projects, scraps, journal pages that didn't work, experiments, painted papers, etc.
- Your favorite stamps
- Archival Jet Black ink by Ranger
- Artist tape by Dina Wakley Media
- Kraft tags by Ranger

Tip: When you buy new stamps, use black ink to stamp them many times in a journal. When you need an image, flip through the journal and cut out an image.

Tip: Use your collage papers to create funky tags with the “gallon, quart, pint” rule of color.

1. Choose three collage papers.
2. Cut out some stamped images (black ink on white paper is great).
3. Cut the collage papers into different sized pieces. Edge the pieces with black ink.
4. Glue the papers onto the tag. When you assemble the tag, use the “gallon, quart, pint” rule. The rule is one of the papers is your gallon color, use the most of that one. The second paper is your quart paper. Use less of that one and overlap the first paper. The third paper is your pint paper. Use only a small amount of that paper. Make sure all of your papers overlap.
5. Edge the tag with black ink.
6. Add printed artist tape as desired.
7. Glue on your stamped image.
