

Quick Technique-Stencil on Polymer Clay

Materials:

1 package (2 ounce) of Premo! black polymer clay

Clay blade

Stencil-I used my own border design, Pilgrimage to the Renaissance, from Stencil Girl

Rolling pin or even PVC pipe works

Golden Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold paint

Gold pulver/mica powder - Eberhard Faber

Instructions:

Roll out one package (2 ounce) of black polymer clay into a slab about 1/8 inch thick.

Place border stencil onto clay and lightly set the stencil by pushing it onto the clay slab.

Use a rolling pin and firmly roll over the clay back and forth a few times thereby “embossing” the stencil image onto the clay. Carefully lift off the stencil.

Use acrylic paint and a bit of Mica powder mixed in and lightly rub over stenciled design just hitting the top of the embossed design. Add a little paint to the edges if desired.

Bake as directed- I generally bake for 25 minutes in a 275° toaster oven.
