

# Stamp and Resin Multi Layered Pendant Cat Kerr

## **Material List:**

- Metal Bezels
- "I See You" Rubber Stamps by Cat Kerr

- Oven Baked Clay (any light color will work)
- Clay roller
- Metallic Powder with dry Brush <https://www.moldputty.com/>
- Toaster Oven
- Amazing Clear Cast <https://www.moldputty.com/>
- Measure Cups and Popsicle Sticks
- Glitter/Sequin
- Water Mark Ink Pad
- Metallic Embossing Powder <https://www.moldputty.com/>
- Heat Gun
- Awl
- Black Paint/or Metallic Luster
- Water based White Sharpie
- Wax Paper

## **Instructions:**

1. Add oven baked Clay to bezel then add image by pressing stamp into clay.
2. Add Metallic Powder with Dry brush.
3. Bake in clay designated Toaster Oven following clay directions.
4. Mix two equal parts of Amazing Clear Cast and add to bezel. Wait approx. 20 minutes and sprinkle on sequins/glitter and let cure.
5. Add a water mark image with a different stamp to the top of the cured resin and cover in Embossing powder. Melt with a heat gun.
6. Mix another batch of Amazing Clear Cast and add to bezel and let cure.
7. Add additional Texture to the cured resin layer by making scratch marks and filling the marks with paint. Clean off excess with baby wipe.
8. Add White Sharpie marks.
9. Add one final layer of Clear Cast Resin and let cure.
