Instructions:

1. Tape down embossing folders if necessary.
2. Mix two equal parts of Casting Resin and pour on embossing folder. Spread out with a popsicle stick and let cure.
3. Peel off and cut to fit sides of shadowbox shrine.
4. Glue resin sheets to shadowbox shrine.
5. Add Gesso.
6. Add Paint.
7. Using a glue stick add paper to the inside of the shrine.
8. Add Sharpie marks.
9. Add Metallic Lustre.
10. Paint Relic and distress. Glue to the inside of the shrine as well as a sticker word.
