Jointed Paper Dolls - Cynthia Thornton

Materials:

Watercolor paper
Tracing paper
Transfer sheet
Pencil
Watercolor from Daniel Smith
Gouache
Waterbrush
Scissors
Brads
Uniball Signo white pigment pen
Palette for mixing colors

Instructions:

- 1. Start with a sketch of the subject, roughing in how you want the doll to look completed. Then, outline the pieces of the doll, focusing in on the joints.
- 2. Use tracing paper to outline parts separately.
- 3. Transfer outlines of parts onto watercolor paper with a light box, or sunny window.
- 4. Start with watercolor washes and block out colors of pieces.
- 5. When dry, use gouache to accent the highlights and shadows.
- 6. Use pens and markers to add details.
- 7. Punch holes for the brads using a push pin.
- 8. Cut out the pieces.
- 9. Darken edges of pieces with a marker to cover white cut edges, this gives the piece more dimension.
- 10. Assemble and place into frame.
