Cat Kerr - Apoxie Clay Bangles

Material List:

- 16 gauge Copper Wire
- Bracelet mandrel or can
- Rawhide hammer
- Wire Cutter
- Apoxie Sculpt by Aves <u>https://www.avesstudio.com/</u>
- Gloves
- Small Clip Clamps
- Premade mold or make your own with Amazing Mold Putty
- Americana Coastal Waters Multi Surface Acylic Paint
- Deco Arts Media Fluid Burnt Umber
- Deco Arts Extreme Sheen Acrylic Paint 24 Gold
- 2mm Leather Cord
- Baby powder

Step by Step:

- 1. Cut an 8" piece of copper wire and wrap it around the mandrel/can. Work harden it with the rawhide hammer.
- 2. Put on some gloves and mix up two equal parts of Apoxie sculp. Let it rest for approx. 2 minutes.
- 3. Add a little bit of baby powder into the mold. Press some AS into the mold. You don't want to over fill it.
- 4. Press the two open ends of the wire into the back of the AS and then take a small piece of AS and place it over the wire. Use the clamps to keep the wire upright while it cures. I prefer to let it cure 24 hrs. Next remove the piece from the mold.
- 5. Paint the front and back in Coastal Waters and let cure.
- 6. Paint it completely in Burnt Umber Media Fluid, wait a few minutes and then use a paper towel to remove some of the burnt umber and let dry.
- 7. Finish off the focal by adding some Gold paint.
- 8. Cut a 15" piece of 2mm leather cord. Hold a 2" tail on one side and tightly wrap it around the wire side 4 or 5 times. Next wrap it on the opposite side 4-5 times and bring it back to the original side and tie a knot. If desired add a drop of glue to the knot.
