"Recording" Special Events – Creating Keepsakes with Vinyl Records by Karenliz Henderson



To complete this project, you will need the following supplies:

- The Crafters Workshop Stencil
 - TCW803 Distressed Lace
- The Crafters Workshop Mixed Media Products
 - TCW9001 White Gesso or TCW9002 Black Gesso
 - TCW9004 Light & Fluffy Modeling Paste or TCW9047 Black Modeling Paste
 - TCW9006 Gel Medium Matte
- The Crafters Workshop Heavy Body Acrylic Paint
 - TCW9023 Jellybean
 - TCW9016 Spun Sugar
- Craft Paint Lime Green
- Vinyl Record from friends/family or thrift store. Make sure you wash the record with soap and water.
- Your favorite photo. Up to 4x6. Crop your picture anyway you want.
- Cardstock
- Glue stick
- Palette Knife
- Make up sponges

Photograph -

- Choose your photograph(s). I've used up to 4x6. Crop it and attached it to cardstock. The cardstock will protect the picture. You can also frame your picture too.
- Create a mask. Make sure it's the same size of the photo or frame.
- You will place the mask were your photo will be on the vinyl record. Use a glue stick to attach the mask to the record.

Vinyl Records -

• They are plastic. If your paints are not formulated to work on plastic you must use gesso first. Gesso has a binder in it so that it will give the surface tooth so that the paints sticks.

To Start -

1. Place your photo mask where you want your photograph. Use a glue stick on the bottom of the mask to keep it in place.



- 2. Place the stencil on the record.
- 3. Using a makeup sponge add TCW White or TCW Black Gesso through the stencil. Remember less is more. Pounce the sponge in the gesso and then pounce off the extra.



- 4. Before you take the stencil off, place a mark in one corner on the stencil with paint. This will help you align the stencil back on the record for the next step.
- 5. Using a palette knife carefully add the TCW Light & Fluffy Modeling Paste to the stencil. If you want your colors to be more richer/muted use TCW Black Modeling Paste.



- 6. When you're finished adding TCW Light & Fluffy Modeling Paste, remove the photo mask off so it doesn't stick to the paste. Don't forget to clean off the paste from the stencil.
- 7. When the modeling paste is dry, put the stencil back on the record. This makes it easier to paint the modeling paste.
- 8. Using a makeup sponge add paint. Remember less is more. Pull off the stencil and use a paint brush for any touch ups, if any.



- 9. When everything is dry add your photo. Either use double-sided tape, TCW Gel medium or multi-use glue.
- 10. To hang the records, I've used the following:
 - Adjustable Plate Hangers
